CUVAS Bahawalpur Distributes Scholarships Worth PKR 6.5 Million Among Students

On July 15th, 2025, at Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (CUVAS) Bahawalpur, the Financial Aid Office distributed cheques under the Hunar Scholarship and Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship programs.

The ceremony was presided over by Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz. Registrar Dr. Faisal Siddiq, Director Financial Aid Office Dr. Arsalan Sehgal, and Focal Person for Hunar Scholarship Dr. Muhammad Luqman were also present and distributed cheques among the scholarship recipients. A total of 92 deserving students received cheques, with the scholarships amounting to approximately PKR 6.5 million. Dr. Arsalan Sehgal shared that nearly 40% of CUVAS students are currently studying under various scholarship programs and reaffirmed the commitment to ensuring that every student receives financial support for higher education.

Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz reiterated the university's vision, stating that *"We believe in transformation through education, and these scholarships are an effort to empower our students to achieve academic and personal success."* The event marked a significant step forward in the university's efforts to provide financial assistance and promote educational excellence.



CUVAS Bahawalpur Observes World Hepatitis Day with Awareness Seminar

On July 22nd, 2025, Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (CUVAS) Bahawalpur, in collaboration with the Pakistan Society for the Study of Liver Diseases (PSSLD), organized an awareness program to highlight the importance of liver health and prevention of hepatitis. The chief guest of the program was Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz, while the keynote speaker was Prof. Dr. Qazi Masroor Ali (former Head of Medicine, former Director DME, and Joint Secretary PSSLD).

Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz welcomed the distinguished guest and emphasized that hepatitis, though invisible, can lead to fatal consequences. Currently, 345 million people worldwide are affected by this disease, which is treatable with timely care. He urged that it is everyone's responsibility not only to protect themselves but also to spread awareness among their families and communities, especially the youth. In his detailed lecture, Prof. Dr. Qazi Masroor Ali explained the types, transmission, and treatment of hepatitis. He stated that Hepatitis A and E spread through contaminated food and water, while B and C transmit through blood, unsafe injections, mother-to-child transmission, and sexual contact. He highlighted common symptoms including fatigue, vomiting blood, lethargy, liver cancer, and irritability. Prof. Dr. Qazi Masroor Ali shared that around 1.3 million people die each year due to hepatitis, stressing the need for regular testing and timely vaccination for prevention.





CUVAS Bahawalpur Hosts International Webinar on Acupuncture and Ethnoveterinary Medicine

On August 7th, 2025, Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (CUVAS) Bahawalpur organized an international webinar under the supervision of Dr. Amjad Islam Aqib, Assistant Professor, Department of Medicine, with Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz as the patron. The webinar trainer was Dr. Adnan Hasan Tahir, Assistant Professor, Department of Clinical Sciences, PMAS-Arid Agriculture University, Rawalpindi.

Addressing the session, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Mazhar Ayaz shared that the Department of Medicine at CUVAS is committed to establishing a *Centre of Excellence for Acupuncture, Ethnoveterinary Medicine, and Unani Medicine*. He also mentioned signing a *Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)* with a Chinese university during his recent visit to China.

Dr. Adnan Hasan Tahir has been working on acupuncture techniques since his PhD and possesses extensive practical experience in treating animals, as well as successfully treating humans.

The webinar was hosted by Dr. Amjad Islam Aqib, who has conducted a series of webinars and workshops this summer, benefiting over 300 participants from 10 countries. Dr. Amjad Islam Aqib also serves as the focal person for establishing the Centre of Excellence in Acupuncture, Ethnoveterinary, and Unani Medicine.

Following the webinar, an important meeting was held between the Vice Chancellor and the host to discuss future plans for establishing the Centre, which will make CUVAS the first university in Pakistan to launch such a facility.

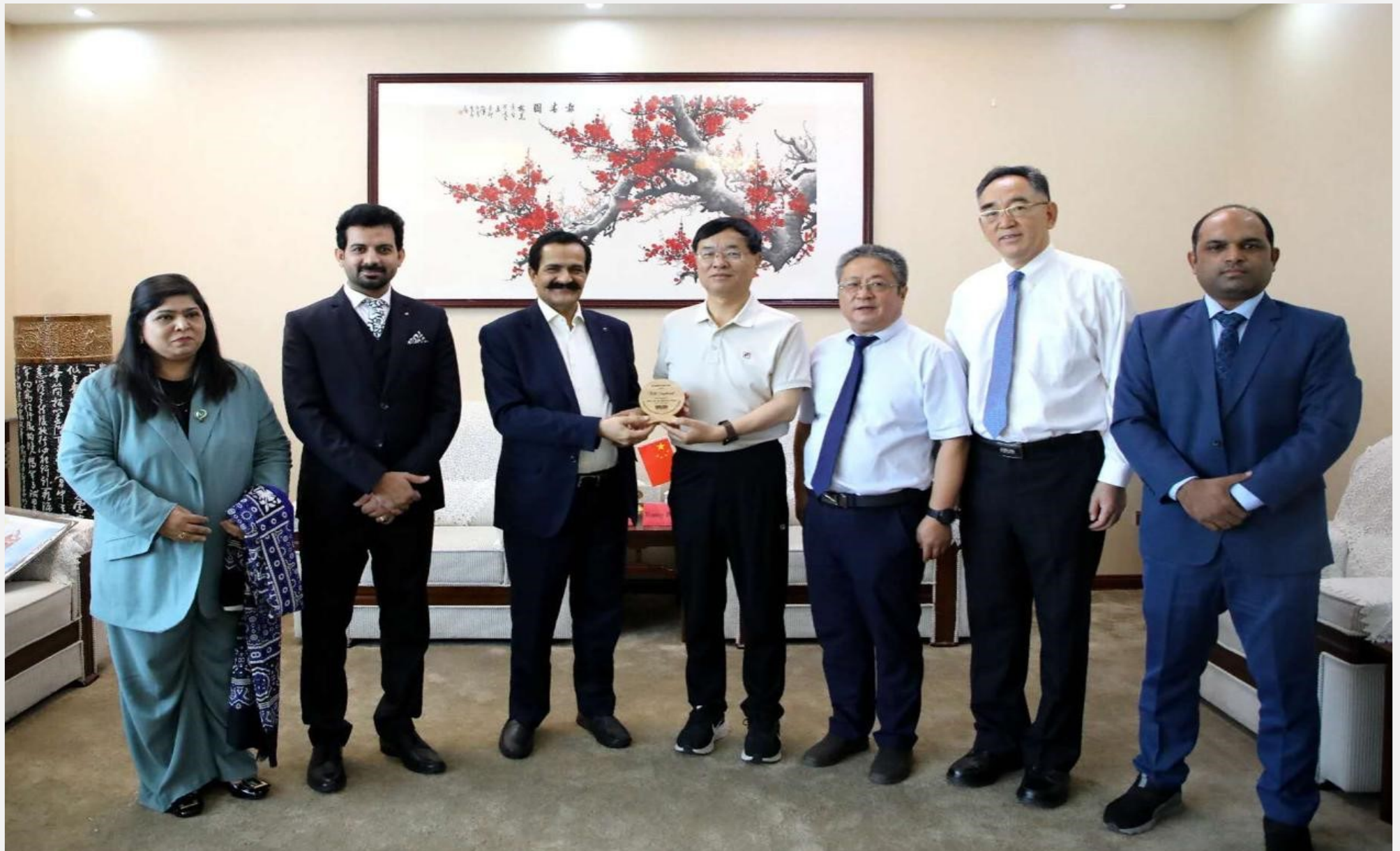

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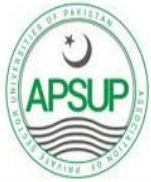
